



295 | TRIPLE BRIDGES REPLACEMENT

Waterview Avenue Bridge Partial Closure Detour Information

On **Thursday, March 12, 2020**, the Waterview Avenue Bridge will become more restrictive with only one lane of travel available in each direction, and the addition of a new temporary signal for vehicular traffic. On **Friday, March 13, 2020 and Monday, March 16, 2020**, only a single interchangeable lane will be available for vehicular traffic, between the hours of **9:00 am – 4:00 pm**. The new temporary signal will be used to control the flow of traffic on these dates.

These activities and changes are in preparation for the 18 month total closure of the north half of the bridge for full demolition and reconstruction. In advance of these changes, you will notice signage being installed and messaging displayed on variable message boards.

PEDESTRIAN DETOUR INFORMATION

Once the north half of the bridge is closed, the north sidewalk across the bridge will no longer be available to pedestrians. **The nearby Maisel Street pedestrian bridge will become the primary on-foot detour during the 18 month duration of the north half closure.** While the sidewalk on the south half of the Waterview Avenue bridge will remain open, it is not encouraged for use as it will place pedestrians adjacent to an active construction zone.

VEHICLE DETOUR INFORMATION

On the weekend of **March 21-22, 2020**, a two day vehicular detour will be implemented to allow for bridge work that must occur in the east intersection of Waterview Avenue and Annapolis Road. **Please click [here](#) for detour routes** for the weekend closure and during the 18 month total closure of the north half of the bridge.
